I have a Bonair evaporative air con. They seem to be pretty much a muchness between the brands. You can get different size units depending on the size of the area you want to cool. I strongly recommend that they install a Hydrosmart especially if they have calcium or high mineral content in their water. This will considerably extend the life of the pads resulting in a saving of money in not having to replace the pads as often and having to get their air con serviced as often due to cleaner water running through the system. This also applies to the pump as with no mineral or calcium build up the pump will run freer with less load on it.

Of the Hydrosmart units that I have installed here in Alice I have only had excellent reports from them.

I had one family that have a daughter that has bad EXMA due to the harshness of the water here. They installed a Hydrosmart unit hoping that it would help her. On speaking to them on a later date they informed me that her EXMA had virtually cleared up and that it seemed to be from what the Hydrosmart had done to the water.

If you want to follow this up, let me know and I'll give you their details. There may be something in it.
